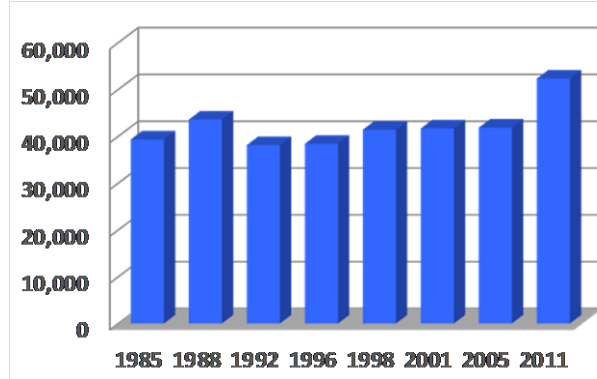
3. Shift of Christianity to Global South

| 1900 | 90% | 10% |
| 1979 | 50% | 50% |
| 2016 | 24% | 76% |

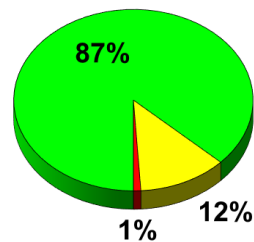
The "center" of Christianity has moved out of Europe and North America and now rests in Asia, Africa and Latin America.



2. Improving Career N. Amer Missionaries



Between 1985 and 2005 the number of career (4+ years) North American missionaries sent out was fairly stagnant. But since 2005 there has been a significant increase.



4. Foreign Missions Resource Allocation

| Category | % of Foreign Missions Giving |
|---|------------------------------|
| Giving to Foreign Missions for work among already Christian groups | 87% |
| Giving to Foreign Missions for work among people that live within reach of the Gospel but haven't responded | 12% |
| Giving to Foreign Missions for work among unreached people groups. | 1% |
