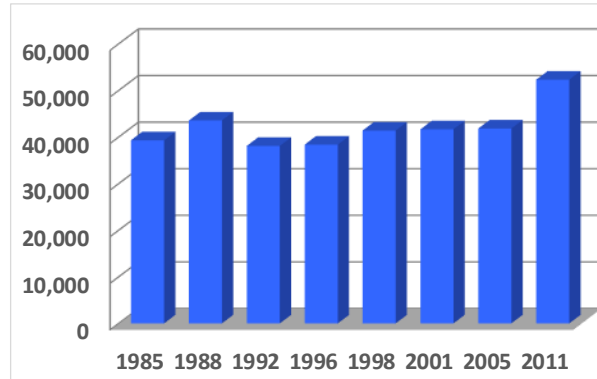
## 3. Shift of Christianity to Global South

2018	23%	77%

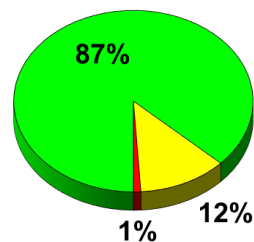
The "center" of Christianity has moved out of Europe and North America and now rests in Asia, Africa and Latin America.



## 2. Improving Career N. Amer Missionaries



Between 1985 and 2005 the number of career (4+ years) North American missionaries sent out was fairly stagnant. But since 2005 there has been a significant increase.



## 4. Foreign Missions Resource Allocation

81% of the world's Hindu, Muslims, and Buddhists do not personally know a Christian.
