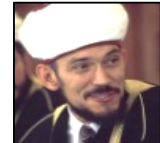

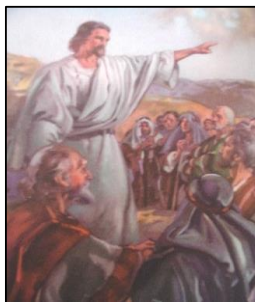

- \*\* Pray for great people movements to Christ and Church Planting Movements!
- \*\* Pray that new converts will be biblically disciplined and will grow in Jesus!



### **God answers prayer for UPGs! An example are the Cholanaikkans of Kerala, South India!**

\*\*\* In the late 1960s the Cholanaikkans of Kerala, South India were discovered living naked in caves and completely unreached. Local Kerala Christians began praying for them and sent church planting teams to reach them. Within a few years the Cholanaikkans' lives improved, many became believers in Jesus, and a church was built with half the Cholanaikkans attending, PTL!
